>> When she was battling breast cancer, the late Texan collector and hot sauce heir Linda Pace asked the British-Ghanaian architect David Adjaye to design a gallery for her contemporary art. Following her death in 2007, her foundation has shepherded her vision forward and her collection will finally open to the public in San Antonio on October 13 in a red concrete museum called Ruby City. The inaugural show, Waking Dream (until 2022), includes works by British sculptor Rachel Whiteread, Korean artist Do Ho Suh and American artist Glenn Ligon, among many others.
